PREPARING OUR HEARTS FOR THE COMING SEASON OF PASSION WEEK AND EASTER

This plan is designed to be a guide. Feel free to adapt it to your own needs and circumstances. Remember that the most important aspect is to spend quality time with God, allowing Him to work in your heart.

Day 1: Personal Repentance

- · Theme: Examining Our Hearts
- Scripture: Psalm 139:23-24 "Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting."
- Meditation & Prayer: Spend time reflecting on your relationship with God. Identify areas where you have fallen short, where you need to repent, and where you need to seek forgiveness. Confess these things to God and ask for His grace to help you change. Consider specific actions you can take to make amends for any wrongdoing.

Day 2: Church-Wide Renewal

- · Theme: Unity and Forgiveness
- **Scripture:** Ephesians 4:32 "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."
- Meditation & Prayer: Reflect on the unity of the church body. Pray for forgiveness for any hurts or offenses you have caused within the church community. Ask God to reveal any areas where you need to extend forgiveness to others. Consider how you can actively contribute to a more loving and unified church.

Day 3: National Revival

- Theme: Praying for Our Nation
- Scripture: 1 Timothy 2:1-2 "I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and giving thanks be made for all people— for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness."
- **Meditation & Prayer:** : Pray for our nation's leaders, its institutions, and its people. Intercede for justice, righteousness, and

peace. Ask God to bring revival to Singapore, turning hearts towards Him. Consider specific issues facing us as a nation and pray for God's intervention.

Day 4: The Cost of Salvation

- · Theme: : Gratitude for Christ's Sacrifice
- Scripture: John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."
- Meditation & Prayer: Meditate on the immense love of God demonstrated in the sacrifice of Jesus Christ. Reflect on the suffering He endured for your salvation. Express gratitude for His gift of forgiveness and eternal life. Consider how you can show your love and gratitude to Him. Spend time in worship, expressing your thankfulness to God.

Day 5: Hope of Resurrection

- Theme: Celebrating the Victory of Easter
- Scripture: 1 Corinthians 15:57 "But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."
- Meditation & Prayer: Focus on the hope and joy of the resurrection. Celebrate the victory of Christ over sin and death. Allow the promise of eternal life to fill you with peace and confidence. Consider how this hope impacts your daily life and your interactions with others. As the Lord leads you, share the good news of the resurrection with someone who needs to hear it.
