## FROM THE PASTOR'S HEART

Dear brothers and sisters, today is Palm Sunday. It is the day where Jesus entered Jerusalem on a donkey, getting ready for his royal ascension. Luke 19:28-40 recorded how Jesus went about his journey up to Jerusalem, and the response of the people as he entered Jerusalem.

There were people who were willing to let Jesus use their colt. There were also those who threw their cloaks on the colt and also spread them on the road as a sign of honour for the king who was coming. In verse 37 it says, "... the whole crowd began joyfully to praise God in loud voices for all the miracles they have seen." They had seen the mighty works of Jesus and gave affirmation to the ministry of Jesus, praising God joyfully with a declaration, "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" They may not have understood how Jesus was going to ascend to the Throne, yet they gave all honour and praise for every work that they had seen in Jesus.

In verses 39-40, however, we see the complaint of the Pharisees. It is recorded that some of the Pharisees said to Jesus, "Teacher, rebuke your disciples." For all the wonderful mighty good works of Jesus that were presented to them, they simply could not see what God was doing through Jesus Christ. Instead, they could only see how their administrative and spiritual authority were affected. I feel sad for them because they were diligent and faithful to guard the faith, especially during the 400 years of silence between the Old Testament and New Testament. It is sad that for all the years of hard work to guard and protect the Jews from worldly influence of the Roman culture, it blinded them from what truly mattered.

Dear brothers and sisters, as we step into Holy Week. Let us reflect on the mighty works of Jesus Christ our Lord through the Cross. Give Him all praise and honour for all that He has done for us. May the Lord bless us with spiritual insight and discernment to recognise His voice and receive His blessings and plans for us. Amen!
