Digital Missions: Missions in the 4th Era

Dear Church Family,

This Missions Sunday, we stand at the threshold of a new frontier—one that is reshaping how we fulfill the Great Commission. Our theme, “**Digital Missions: Missions in the 4th Era**,” reflects a pivotal moment in history. Join us this week in fervent prayer for our upcoming Missions Sunday and Combined Church Missions Prayer Meeting. Let us intercede together, believing God for a mighty move of His Spirit. Members can choose to pray for one, several, or all items each day.

Monday: Anointing for Church Missions Prayer Meetings

Scripture: *"If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land."* – **2 Chronicles 7:14 (NIV)**

Prayer Focus: Pray for God's presence and anointing to fill every prayer meeting when God's people gather. Ask for hearts to be open, faith to be strengthened, and the Holy Spirit to lead every moment.

Prayer Guide: Heavenly Father, we ask for Your divine presence to overshadow every Missions Prayer Meeting in Kum Yan and in Singapore. Anoint every word spoken, every prayer lifted, and every heart present. Let Your Spirit move mightily, stirring faith and passion for global missions. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Tuesday: Stirring Intercessors for Global Missions

Scripture: *"Then He said to His disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into His harvest field.'"* – **Matthew 9:37-38 (NIV)**

Prayer Focus: Pray that many will be burdened to intercede for global missions. Ask God to raise up labourers and send them into the harvest.

Prayer Guide: Lord of the Harvest, awaken Your church to the urgency of global missions. Stir hearts to pray, give, and go. Raise up intercessors who will stand in the gap for the unreached. Send forth labourers into Your fields, equipped by Your Spirit. Amen.

Wednesday: Wisdom & Anointing for Prayer Coordinators

Scripture: *"If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."* – **James 1:5 (NIV)**

Prayer Focus: Pray for Prayer Coordinators all over Singapore to be led by the Holy Spirit, guiding God's people into deep, effective intercession for missions.

Prayer Guide: Father, we lift up all Prayer Coordinators to You. Grant them divine wisdom, discernment, and anointing as they lead us into Your presence in prayer. May their prayers and guidance align with Your will, drawing us closer to Your throne. Amen.

Thursday: Anointing for Missionaries and Mission Workers

Scripture: *"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses..."* – **Acts 1:8 (NIV)**

Prayer Focus: Pray for clarity, boldness, and anointing upon every M/MW. Ask God to use them to ignite passion for Jesus and His Kingdom.

Prayer Guide: Lord, we ask for a fresh outpouring of Your Spirit upon our Missionaries and Mission Workers. Fill them with wisdom, clarity, and boldness. Let their words inspire, equip, and stir hearts to faith in Jesus. Amen.

Friday: KY church to Catch the Vision & Be Stirred by the Holy Spirit

Scripture: *"Where there is no vision, the people perish..."* – **Proverbs 29:18 (KJV)**

Prayer Focus: Pray that every church member will be moved by the Holy Spirit, embracing God's heart for missions and responding in faith.

Prayer Guide: Holy Spirit, open the eyes of every heart to see the urgency of global missions. Stir passion, commitment, and action in each person. Let no one leave unchanged, but rather, send them forth with a burning desire to fulfill the Great Commission. Amen.

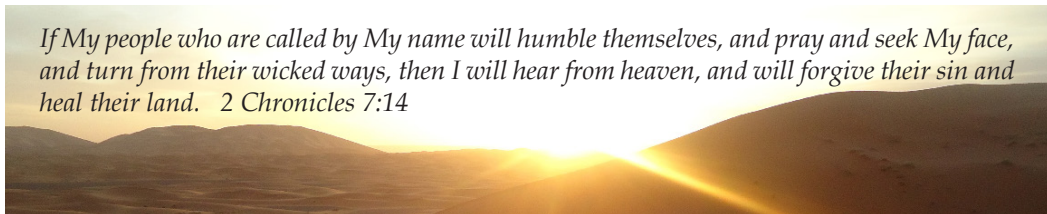
