






### ROMANS 12:3-8

<sup>3</sup> For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the measure of faith God has given you. <sup>4</sup> Just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, <sup>5</sup> so in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.

### ROMANS 12:3-8

<sup>6</sup> We have different gifts, according to the grace given us. If a man's gift is prophesying, let him use it in proportion to his faith.<sup>7</sup> If it is serving, let him serve; if it is teaching, let him teach; <sup>8</sup> if it is encouraging, let him encourage; if it is contributing to the needs of others, let him give generously; if it is leadership, let him govern diligently; if it is showing mercy, let him do it cheerfully.

#### ROMANS 12:3-8 (PARAPHRASED BY SIMON SAY)

"Just as I, Paul, received God's grace to be an apostle, the first thing I want to teach you is that through that same grace you are to contribute to the Church using your God-given gifts. You have a vital part to play because you belong to Christ' body, the Church. Everyone is responsible for his or her part of the work. So don't esteem yourself higher than is necessary. Instead you are to humbly think about how you can contribute effectively to the health of the body. Failure to do so will affect the church in a negative way. So whether you are gifted with say, the prophetic, or serving, teaching, encouraging, giving, leading, or showing mercy, do it well, do it willingly, do it all for the glory of God."

## 3 BIBLICAL TRUTHS FROM ROM 12:3-8



- Our service, o (Rom. 12:1)
- God is spirit (John 4:24; 2 Cor. 3:17)
- Gift, in Greek, 'charisma' i.e. 'gift of grace' (Rom. 12:6)
- Gift is given by the grace of God
- Given by God, Son & Holy Spirit (Rom. 12:3; Eph. 3:7; 1 Cor. 12:7-11)
- Bearing the fruit of the Spirit as we use our gifts

## **BEARING THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT, USING GIFT/S**

"If you preach, just preach God's Message, nothing else; if you help, just help, <u>don't take over</u>; if you teach, <u>stick</u> to your teaching; if you give encouraging guidance, be careful that you don't get bossy; if you're put in charge, don't manipulate; if you're called to give aid to people in distress, keep your eyes open and be quick to respond; if you work with the disadvantaged, <u>don't let yourself get</u> irritated with them or depressed by them. Keep a smile on your face." (ROMANS 12:6-8 MSG)


