


### **COLOSSIANS 1:28-29 (NASB 95)**


# THE WAY OF THE TRUE DISCIPLE

- 3 distinguishing marks:
- 1. To Proclaim the Person (1: 28)
- 2. The People to Preach (1: 28)
- 3. In the Power of the Paraclete (1: 29)




### **Proclaim the Person (1: 28)**

- HEART of discipleship: The Person, Jesus Christ! (Col. 1:27; 2 Cor. 4:5)
- PROCLAIM: to announce an important news throughout, far & wide
  - WHY Salvation is found in no one else but Jesus (Acts 4:12; John 14:6)
  - HOW Proclaim through Admonishing and Teaching
  - WHAT Jesus Christ, His death and resurrection (John 3:16; Romans 10:9)
  - WHEN Anytime, Anywhere
