2) God's Word is our guide in all of life

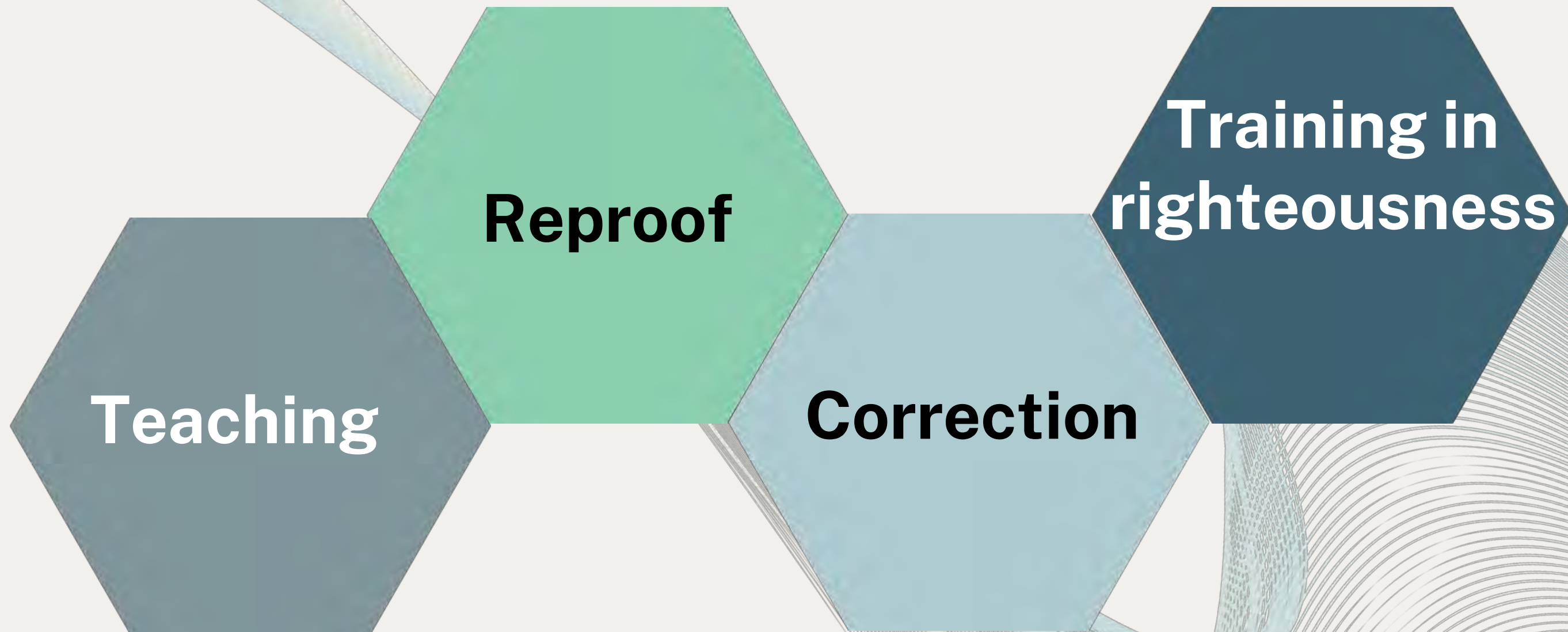
- One step at a time
