
The religious leaders' perspective: I'm in control






Luke 19: 39 - 40

Applications

- 1. Focus on understanding spiritual needs and truths, while avoiding self-centredness and engaging in community service for personal and communal spiritual growth.**
- 2. Acknowledge the limitations of human control, surrender to God's sovereignty, and cultivate humility and openness to His guidance, trusting in His wisdom and goodness even in challenging circumstances.**
- 3. Embrace trust in God's perfect timing and sovereignty, seeking spiritual discernment to align with His will beyond immediate expectations or personal desires.**
