Faith in America

Pew Research - A new survey finds that a majority of self-identified Christians don't care what God thinks about the issue of sex. >50% said casual sex is sometimes or always acceptable

LifeWay Research - 2 out of 3 Americans confess to being a sinner (67%). The rest don't see themselves as sinners (8%), don't think sin exists (10%), or preferred not to answer the question (15%).

Twitter Lent Tracker - Twitter users aren't giving up any of those sins for Lent this year. Social networking topped the list, followed by Twitter, alcohol, chocolate, swearing, and meat.

¹⁵ I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. 16 And if I do what I do not want to do, I agree that the law is good. ¹⁷ As it is, it is no longer I myself who do it, but it is sin living in me. ¹⁸ For I know that good itself does not dwell in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out. 19 For I do not do the good I want to do, but the evil I do not want to do—this I keep on doing. 20 Now if I do what I do not want to do, it is no longer I who do it, but it is sin living in me that does it.

¹⁴ In the morning David wrote a letter to Joab and sent it by the hand of Uriah. ¹⁵ In the letter he wrote, "Set Uriah in the forefront of the hardest fighting, and then draw back from him, that he may be struck down, and die."


Do not love the World

Jesus the Shepherd of Our Souls


