A Pastoral Call to Prayer: From Our Knees to the Nations

Dearly Beloved,

This May, as we focus together on global missions, I want to invite you into something far greater than an event—I invite you into a movement of prayer and mission that stretches beyond walls, beyond borders, and into the very heart of God for the lost.

Why Digital Missions? Why Now?

This year, we're focusing on Digital Missions—because the Great Commission has entered a new frontier. The internet is no longer just a tool; it's a mission field. Billions of people, including many from unreached people groups, are online every day. Some are searching for hope. Some have never heard the name of Jesus. And God is calling us—yes, us—to reach them.

We've prepared workshops and brought in speakers to equip you because this isn't just for "experts." It's for you. You don't need to move overseas to be a missionary. You can share the Gospel through a message, a post, or a video. But first, we must pray. Because before we go—digitally or physically—we must kneel.

An Evening of Igniting the Flame of Missions

On May 2, we'll gather for our Combined Missions Prayer Meeting under the theme: "Praying Beyond Borders—From Our Knees to the Nations."

This isn't just another meeting. It's a divine appointment. We'll intercede for:

- Unreached peoples—those with no access to the Gospel.
- Refugees—the displaced and broken, longing for home.
- Digital missions—asking God to anoint our online witness.
- Our missionaries—standing with them in spiritual warfare.

When we pray, we're not just speaking into the air. We're joining God's global plan. Prayer is the fuel. You are the vessel.

A Personal Plea

Some of you may think, "I'm not a prayer warrior" or "I don't know enough about missions." But this isn't about expertise—it's about obedience and love.

Come because you care. Come because the Holy Spirit might stir something new in you. Come because the harvest is urgent, and your prayers matter more than you know.

Imagine: What if your prayers helped open a door for the Gospel in a closed country?

What if your intercession strengthened a weary missionary at just the right time?

What if God awakened a passion in you to go, send, or serve in ways you never expected?

Let's Gather. Let's Pray.

So I urge you: **Be there.**

Monday: Anointing for the Combined Church Missions Prayer Meeting

Scripture: *"If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land."* – **2 Chronicles 7:14 (NIV)**

Prayer Focus: Pray for God's presence and anointing to fill the meeting. Ask for hearts to be open, faith to be strengthened, and the Holy Spirit to lead every moment.

Prayer Guide: Heavenly Father, we ask for Your divine presence to overshadow our Missions Prayer Meeting. Anoint every word spoken, every prayer lifted, and every heart present. Let Your Spirit move mightily, stirring faith and passion for global missions. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Tuesday: Stirring Intercessors for Global Missions

Scripture: *"Then He said to His disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into His harvest field.'"* – **Matthew 9:37-38 (NIV)**

Prayer Focus: Pray that many will be burdened to intercede for global missions. Ask God to raise up labourers and send them into the harvest.

Prayer Guide: Lord of the Harvest, awaken Your church to the urgency of global missions. Stir hearts to pray, give, and go. Raise up intercessors who will stand in the gap for the unreached. Send forth labourers into Your fields, equipped by Your Spirit. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Wednesday: Wisdom & Anointing for the Prayer Coordinators

Scripture: *"If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."* – **James 1:5 (NIV)**

Prayer Focus: Pray for the Prayer Coordinators to be led by the Holy Spirit, guiding God's people into deep, effective intercession.

Prayer Guide: Father, we lift up our Prayer Coordinators to You. Grant them divine wisdom, discernment, and anointing as they lead us into Your presence. May their prayers and guidance align with Your will, drawing us closer to Your throne. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Thursday: Anointing for Missions Sunday Speakers & Workshop Presenters

Scripture: *"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses..."* – **Acts 1:8 (NIV)**

Prayer Focus: Pray for clarity, boldness, and anointing upon every speaker and workshop leader. Ask God to use them to ignite passion for missions.

Prayer Guide: Lord, we ask for a fresh outpouring of Your Spirit upon our Missions Sunday speakers and workshop presenters. Fill them with wisdom, clarity, and boldness. Let their words inspire, equip, and stir hearts to action. In Jesus' name,, Amen.

Friday: Attendees to Catch the Vision & Be Stirred by the Holy Spirit

Scripture: *"Where there is no vision, the people perish..."* – **Proverbs 29:18 (KJV)**

Prayer Focus: Pray that every attendee will be moved by the Holy Spirit, embracing God's heart for missions and responding in faith.

Prayer Guide: Holy Spirit, open the eyes of every heart to see the urgency of global missions. Stir passion, commitment, and action in each person. Let no one leave unchanged, but rather, send them forth with a burning desire to fulfill the Great Commission. In Jesus' name, Amen.
