[18] "Listen then to what the parable of the sower means: [19] When anyone hears the message about the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is the seed sown along the path. [20] The one who received the seed that fell on rocky places is the man who hears the word and at once receives it with joy. [21] But since he has no root, he lasts only a short time. When trouble or persecution comes because of the word, he quickly falls away. [22] The one who received the seed that fell among the thorns is the man who hears the word, but the worries of this life and the deceitfulness of wealth choke it, making it unfruitful. [23] But the one who received the seed that fell on good soil is the man who hears the word and understands it. He produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown."

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1. DIFFICULT TIMES & DISCOURAGEMENT UN-DEALT WITH (13:19)

The one who received the seed that fell on rocky places is the man who hears the word and at once receives it with joy. But since he has no root, he lasts only a short time. When trouble or persecution comes because of the word, he quickly falls away. (Matthew 13:20-21)

2. WRONG MOTIVATIONS & DEEP-THIRSTS IN LIFE (13:20-21)

Common Deep Needs:

- i. Need to be secure
- ii. Need to be valued
- iii. Need to be significant

Common Strategies people "Drink" to meet their needs:

- a. performance expectations
- b. control
- c. friendship & nice words

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(Matthew 13:22)

3. MAKING AN <u>UNBIBLICAL</u> RESPONSE TO POSSESSIONS (13:22)




But just as you excel in everything

Biblical Response: Money is a gift from God to be used for blessing and impact

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[29] As he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became as bright as a flash of lightning. [30] Two men, Moses and Elijah, [31] appeared in glorious splendor, talking with Jesus. Then Peter saw his glory and the two men standing with him. Peter said to him, "Master, it is good for us to be here. Let us put up three shelters—one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah." (He did not know what he was saying.) [34] While he was speaking, a cloud appeared and enveloped them, and they were afraid as they entered the cloud. [35] A voice came from the cloud, saying, "This is my Son, whom I have chosen; listen to him."

(Luke 9:29-31, 34-35)

2. How can you create a better environment for yourself to hear God through the Word?

Pick the best ones for yourself and apply!

Common Block 1:

What are some voices of "condemnation & discouragement" that you hear through past difficult times? List them down.

With Friend / Mentor: Find several Bible verses that speak directly to address the thoughts you think about.

We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ. (2 Corinthians 10:5)

Common Block 2:

Of the common strategies people "drink from" shared, which do you find yourself tending to most often? Recall what situations usually trigger this.

With Friend / Mentor: Share this with someone you trust, ask for prayer & encouragement to "drink from God" in such times.

Common Block 3:

To what degree does finance, possessions and worry affect you? Share an instance where you struggled with this, and what God said to you.

With Friend / Mentor: Make a commitment to trust God for your finance, possessions & worries. Share this with someone and ask that person to hold you to it and remind you of your commitment from time to time.
