- 3. Looking at the B.U.I.L.D. application, which one aspect you feel strongest in and which one do you want to grow in? How will you do that?



- I) FOUNDATIONAL, NOT SUPERFICIAL Jesus' words are bedrock commands. (Matt. 7:24)
- It's all about the truth and nothing but the truth (1 Cor. 3:11)!
- Teachers must teach biblical values that endure beyond exams.

- II) PRACTICAL, NOT PRETENTIOUS Jesus applied truth to real life.
- It's practical and useful for every season for all time (2 Tim. 3:16-17)!
- Truth informs but truth applied transforms.

Authority and Authenticity



- I) AUTHORITY WITHOUT ARROGANCE Jesus spoke with divine confidence (John 7:46)
- Students follow consistency more than charisma
- Teachers impact students with their substance, not their status or stature.

II) INTEGRITY WITHOUT INSINCERITY (HYPOCRISY)

Jesus lived what He taught (1 Pet. 2:21). He talked and walked the talk.

- Our life is our sermon!
