Now if we are children, then we are heirs – heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory. I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us. For [the] creation waits in eager expectation for the children of God to be revealed. Discussion Questions

1. When Life Feels Tough:

Paul says both creation and we ourselves "groan" while waiting for God's redemption (Rom 8:22–25).

What are some things happening around us — maybe in our own lives, families, or even our nation — that make you feel this "groaning"? How can hope in Christ help us keep going when life feels exhausting?

2.The Spirit's Help in Weak Moments:

The Bible says the Holy Spirit helps us when we don't know what to pray (Rom 8:26–27). Have you ever felt too overwhelmed or lost for words when praying? How did you sense God's presence or peace during those times?

3. God's Purpose in Our Everyday Lives:

Rom 8:28 is more accurately understood this way: God works all things good *through* those who love Him.

How does it feel to be called to God's purpose whether at work, in school or at home? Share an experience when God was able to use you (eg. to bring encouragement, to give different perspective, etc.) even when things didn't go as expected.
