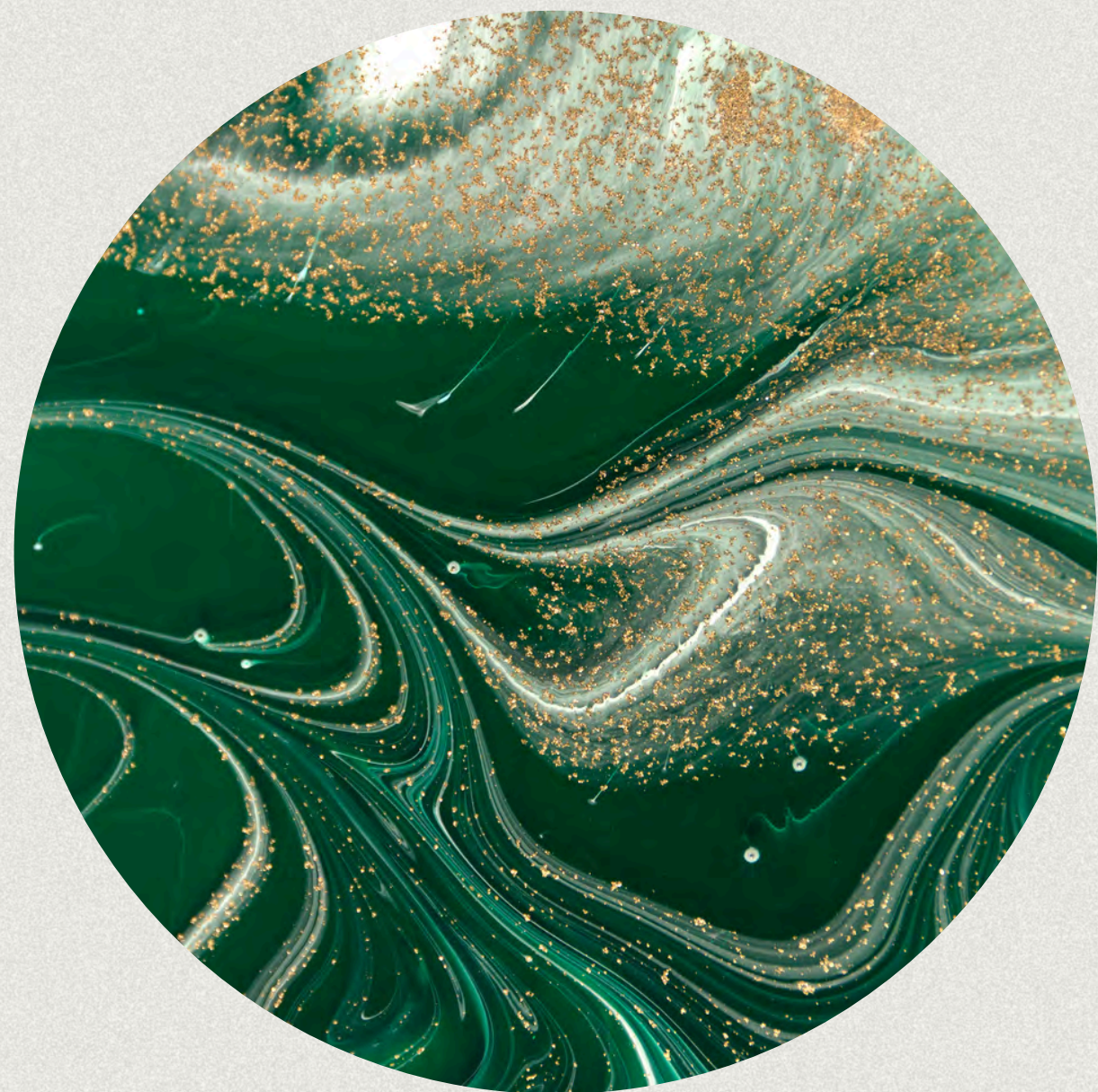

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION
