from the pastor's heart

In the coming months there are a few things we would like to embark on. First, we have seen restrictions relaxed further under Phase 3 of Safe Re-opening. Hence, the most immediate thing we would like to do is to increase the number of on-site worship services for our congregations from once to twice a month. Our goal is to enable everyone to have a chance to come on-site for service at least once-a-month.

Currently, we are exploring the best way to increase each on-site worship service from 100 persons to 150 persons. We are mindful that this has to be done safely and in full compliance with all the safe management requirements. The Pastors and members of the Management Committees are working very hard on this. Do look out for details in the coming weeks.

Another key project that will commence soon is the upgrading of the audio system in our Sanctuary. This entails replacing all our aging sound equipment and the installation of other acoustic treatments including modifications to the canopy attached to the altar area. These upgrading works will resolve existing problems with imbalanced audio frequency and speech clarity. We plan to complete this upgrading project by end-February – in time for our 103rd Church Anniversary celebration in March.

Finally, just a reminder that our Church Office has resumed on-site operations as of 2nd January. You may telephone the Church Office if you have any needs and enquires. Our admin staff would be delighted to serve you. However, if you need to come into the church please make an appointment in advance.

This is because we still have to regulate the number of people entering and exiting the Church. Thank you for your understanding.

2) TICKET REGISTRATION FOR ONSITE SERVICES: IMPORTANT TIPS ON USING EVENTBRITE

Registration for tickets for our on-site services will be done via Eventbrite; and will be open at the start of each month. You may book tickets for either of the two on-site services in that month. Please take note of the following instructions for a smoother process for all:

Registration – Please list all the names and contact details of *each* individual attendee, even when doing a group order.

Cancellations – Only possible for entire orders, NOT for partial cancellation of individual attendees within a group order. For partial cancellations, contact the Church Office or email kyenglishservice@gmail.com, with details of which attendees need to cancel.

Waitlist – this feature will be disabled from February onwards, which means that if tickets are sold out, you'll have to check back from time to time to see if tickets become available.

Sales End – Friday, 12 noon before the event, irrespective of Ticket status. If you need to cancel your orders, try to do so before this time as far as possible to facilitate opening up spots for others to come.

4) TRACETOGETHER APP OR TOKEN

By end December 2020, checking in with the TraceTogether App or Token was made mandatory at places of worship with more than 100 people, as Singapore prepared for Phase 3 of its reopening. This means no one will be able to gain entry to these places by scanning SafeEntry QR codes with their phone cameras, or through the SingPass Mobile App or barcodes on their NRIC.

Effective from January 2021, we would need you to turn on Bluetooth when in church for Service, for as long as you are on the premises.

Please download the TraceTogether App from the App Store or Google Play, or collect a physical Trace Together Token as soon as you can, if you haven't already done so. Let us all do our part to protect ourselves, our loved ones and our community. Together, we can overcome COVID-19.

5) RESUMPTION OF OFFICE OPERATIONS

The Church Office resumed operations on-site from 2 January 2021. However, please note that the Carpark gate and the wooden doors will remain locked. Appointments and prior arrangements to come can be made with the office via the Church Office telephone number.

6) PARKING IN CHURCH

We seek your kind understanding, that because space in the Church carpark is much reduced due to the Safe Management entry / exit set up, priority is given to church staff on duty and ministry volunteers doing work on-site, as well as vendors providing services to the church by appointment and prior arrangement only.

7) SERVICES IN “THE NEW NORMAL”

Thank God! Singapore is now in Phase 3 of Safe Re-opening. While congregational worship services for 250 pax is now allowed, we will be taking gradual steps to increase our numbers, first by working towards having 150 worshippers in 3 zones of 50 persons each.

We urge each one to continue to be vigilant with adhering to safe management measures in place wherever we go; as well as to understand and familiarise ourselves with the rationale and guidelines provided by the authorities. Let us do our part to protect our loved ones and communities with each step we take towards safe re-opening. In summary, measures are in place to minimise the spread of Covid-19 by managing the following:

Density: Worshippers are to be assigned to separate Zones holding no more than 50 persons each, and observe 1m safe distance between them at all times.

Intensity: Face masks must be worn at all times, and there is to be no live singing by the congregation. Worshippers should not mingle with others across groups. Each Zone is to have separate entryways, exits and routes to and from the hall and/or staggered entrance and exit timings.

Duration: Services are to be kept as short as possible, and worshippers are to leave the premises immediately after service.
